STUDY ROOMS

The Adult and Youth Services Departments each have study rooms which will accommodate small groups. Three Adult Services study rooms may be reserved and two are first-come, first-served. Youth Services' two study rooms are first-come, first-served. A patron may reserve a study room on the library website or by contacting the library. Reservation limits and times are available on the library's website. A library card is not required to use the rooms. For the safety of children, use of the Youth Services study rooms by persons older than middle school age is prohibited unless the person is accompanied by a child. The Adult Services rooms may be used by anyone in middle school or older. On occasion the library may reserve the rooms for special purposes.
