PATRONS ALLOWING OTHERS TO ACCESS THEIR LIBRARY ACCOUNTS

In accordance with the Illinois Library Records Confidentiality Act (75 ILCS 70/1-2), the library cannot give anyone access to a patron's library account. However, any resident, temporary resident, nonresident-nontaxpayer or reciprocal borrower library card holder may give written permission for multiple other individuals (Authorized Agents) to access their library account information, checkout, renew, or reserve materials, or to pay fines or fees over the telephone or in person upon presentation of proper ID. The library card holder must appear in person at the library and give permission in writing. This policy does not apply to Nonresident Taxpayer library cards, as use of those is restricted by law.
