ACCEPTABLE USE OF THE HUB

The Hub is a collaborative learning space to explore, design, create, play, and build using a variety of tools, technology, and materials.

All patrons who wish to use the equipment or tools in The Hub must have a valid library card registered with GAPLD and will be required to sign a liability waiver. Patrons under the age of 18 will need to have a parent or guardian sign a minor liability waiver prior to using any equipment or tools in The Hub.

Staff must approve any outside materials used on equipment and reserves the right to disapprove certain materials, tools, or usage of equipment. The library cannot guarantee project quality, equipment availability or stability, confidentiality of designs, or specific delivery times. The library reserves the right to close The Hub or its equipment for public use in order to provide staff training, equipment maintenance, or programs. Patrons will not be permitted to use The Hub's equipment and tools to create materials, projects, or designs that are:

- Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or pose an immediate threat to the well-being of self or others, including but not limited to a weapon or look-alike weapon
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights, including material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection

While The Hub encourages creativity and entrepreneurship, The Hub's equipment is not intended for industrial or commercial purposes.
